Anesthesia machine maintenance **Daily:**

Pressure test machine:

- Attach circuit and re-breathing bag onto machine.
- · Close pop off valve.
- Seal patient end of circuit with thumb.
- Use flush button to fill system to 40 cm-H2O/ on manometer.
- If pressure drops from 40 to 27 cm-H2O in less than 10 seconds, then there is a leak that needs correcting.

Check for leaks: (mix a soapy mixture in a spray bottle)

- Check inspiration and expiration valves.
- · Check around soda lime canister.
- Check fresh gas hose leading to canister.
- · Check pop off valve.
- · Check vaporizer connections.
- · Check breathing bag for holes.

Clean Machine:

- After use, remove bag and wash with a MILD detergent.
- Remove circuit and wash with MILD detergent. Hang to dry.

Weekly:

- Replace CO2 absorbent. This should be done after 8-12 hours of use. DO NOT RELY ON COLOR CHANGE.
- Change activated charcoal canisters after 6-8 hours of use.

Yearly:

Vaporizer cleaning and calibration.
