2-OCTYL CYANOACRYLATE IMPROVES WOUND REPAIR

- The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has approved 2-octyl cyanoacrylate for closure of incised skin. In addition to its surgical adhesive indication, 2-octyl cyanoacrylate was approved by the FDA in January 2001 for use as a barrier against common bacterial microbes, including certain staphylococci, pseudomonads and *Escherichia coli*.**
- Several clinical studies have shown that products containing 2-octyl cyanoacrylate provide results equal to those of sutures. And given the speed and efficacy, Surgi-Lock 2oc provides a better choice than traditional sutures.***

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How does Surgi-Lock 2oc work?

- A: Meridian Animal Health's Surgi-Lock 2oc is a 2-octyl cyanoacrylate adhesive used to bond tissue together for veterinary procedures including, but not limited to, spays, neuters, declaws, dew claw removals, lacerations, etc. When used properly, Surgi-Lock 2oc can eliminate the need for traditional sutures and bandages. The formulation is clear and will polymerize rapidly upon contact with body tissue. Besides working as a tissue adhesive, Surgi-Lock 2oc also serves as a hemostatic agent. Surgi-Lock 2oc will slough off naturally from the animal's body as healing occurs.
- Q. How does Surgi-Lock 2oc provide protection against infection?
- A: Surgi-Lock 2oc provides a needle-free method of wound closure, an important consideration because of blood-borne viruses. Surgi-Lock 2oc functions as a waterproof sealant, providing antimicrobial properties against gram-positive organisms. It has been shown to decrease histologic and clinical infection rates in contaminated wounds when compared to closure with traditional sutures.

Q. Is Surgi-Lock 2oc safe for pets?

- A: Yes, at 98.9%, Surgi-Lock 2oc offers the highest levels of purity available in the marketplace.
- Q. Does Surgi-Lock 2oc help minimize post surgical care?
- A: Yes, there are fewer or no wound dressings to change, and most often a return visit to the veterinarian is not required, which is not the case for sutures that require removal.
