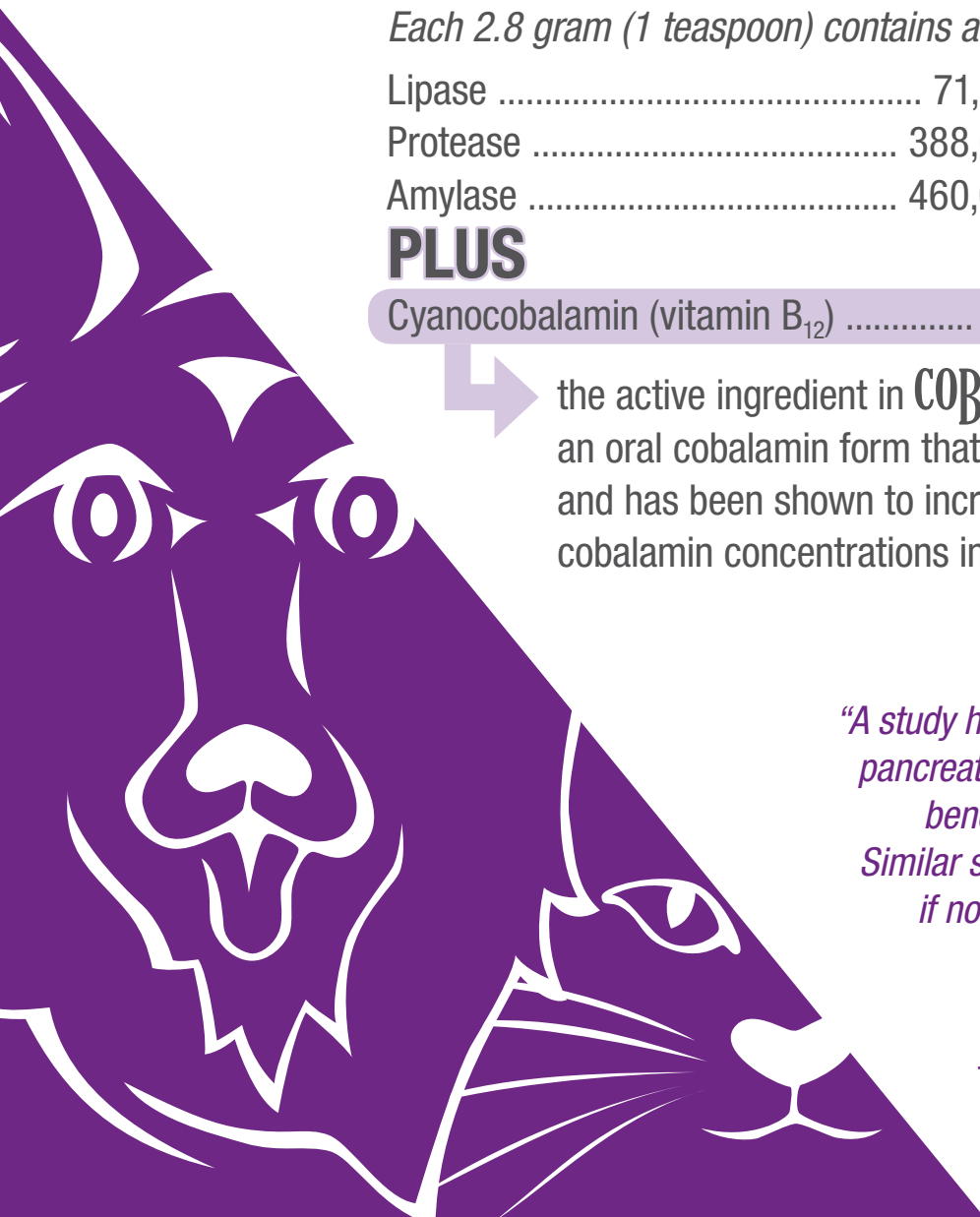

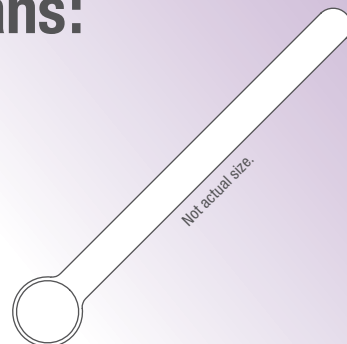

Customary initial amount per meal:

**Dogs: ¾–1 teaspoon (3-4 scoopfuls)**

*Once desired response is achieved and the patient's stool is normal, use the 1/4 teaspoon scoop to reduce the per-meal amount by half a scoopful (1/8 teaspoon). Observe the patient response and stool quality. If the stool becomes loose, increase the per-meal amount to the prior volume. After one week, if the stool is still normal, attempt another half scoopful (1/8 teaspoon) reduction and repeat until the minimum volume, or RIGHT amount, is achieved. Maintain patient using that RIGHT amount with every meal.*
