







Indoors and outdoors, cats use scratching on vertical and horizontal surfaces to convey a territorial message to other cats through pheromone and visual marking.

Indoor scratching can also be a sign of a cat's stress and anxiety. What can cause stress and anxiety?

- Changes in the home after new furniture is introduced or furniture is moved
- Tension and conflicts in multiple-cat households



Improvements in cats exhibiting unwanted scratching

Scratching on vertical surfaces


- 36% of cats stopped inappropriate scratching by day 7
- 66% of cats stopped inappropriate scratching by day 28



For the cats still scratching, the frequency of scratching dropped from once a day to less than once a week on average by day 28.

Cats exhibiting destructive scratching

- 60% of cats stopped inappropriate scratching by day 7
- 84% of cats stopped inappropriate scratching by day 28



For the cats still scratching, the frequency of scratching dropped from once every 2 to 3 days to less than once a week on average by day 28.

Prevents scratching in newly adopted cats/kittens

76% of cats decreased/stopped unwanted scratching following their introduction into a new home

- **Catnip** contributes to attracting some cats to the scratching post
- **Blue stained lines** that mimic the visual message of the scratches, the dye fades over time but does not completely disappear



How to use FELISCRATCH by FELIWAY®

It's simple. Place your scratching post over a sink or on a newspaper and slowly apply the liquid product by drawing 2 or 3 vertical lines on the post. Let dry for 5 minutes and place the post close to the area where your cat scratches or usually rests:

- 1 dose (pipette) daily during the first week
- 1 dose (pipette) at the begining of week
